
Camerawork Silent Health **Events**



EVENING PANEL DISCUSSION Thursday 1st November 7.00pm

An evening discussion focussing on some of the issues raised by the exhibition. With:

JESSICA EVANS (Head of Photography Theory, Polytechnic of Central London) will discuss the social, philosophical and psychological factors leading to unequal health provision for women.

MELANIE FRIEND (member of the women's photography agency 'Format') will speak about her exhibition work, and her previous involvement with representing health issues.

ROBERTA McGRATH (Lecturer and writer on photography and communication) will discuss the repurcussions of the messages being conveyed to women by mainstream Health Education.

JULIA SIMPSON (Co-Editor of the NUCPS Journal) will describe how trades unions are developing new ways of using photography and images to put across more accurate information to women about their health.

EVENING WORKSHOPS Tuesday 6th November 7.00pm

JO SPENCE (Educational Photographer and Writer) will talk about her work in relation

to the politics of health. She will focus particularly on a collection of photographic work, done over eight years, which explores her personal experience of cancer.

Tuesday 13th November 7.00pm

CLAIRE COLLISON (exhibiting photographer) will discuss her photographs representing dimensions of stress-related dis-eases such as ME. She will demonstrate a range of photographic techniques, from montage to back-projections, which can be achieved without a darkroom.

KATE MUSSELWHITE (exhibiting photographer) will lead a schools workshop making 'health souvenirs'. You will be shown how to associate images and phrases, with ideas about health.
